Financial Update

While conducting services at the Sherwood Avenue facility, the continuing expenses for the Brockington facility were being matched with the funds received from VBS, including auction proceeds. These funds and the net proceeds from the sale of our Sherwood Avenue property are included in our "budget overage" to date. Now that we have moved, these expenses will be part of our normal budget.

The net funds **included** in Budget Overage right now are \$520,518.62. As we settle in, we will discuss any adjustments necessary for the church's budget and how to account for the sale proceeds (Building Fund, etc.).

Our budgeted offerings through the end of December were \$140,392.21, and our actual offerings were \$137,922.19.
